Job Purpose:

The Developer II supports the full software development lifecycle by designing, developing, testing, and maintaining secure and scalable applications aligned with BIAN architectural standards. This role incorporates DevOps practices, provides technical support to business units, and offers mentorship to Developer I staff while contributing to system modernization and continuous improvement initiatives.

Key Responsibilities and Duties:

- Analyze, design, develop, test, and document applications in accordance with development standards.
- Collaborate with Software Engineers on system architecture and technical specifications.
- Develop secure, reliable, and maintainable code; conduct comprehensive testing.
- Identify optimization opportunities in legacy and modern systems.
- Support CI/CD pipelines, automation workflows, and deployment activities.
- Contribute to source control management, containerization, environment configuration, and monitoring.
- Support alignment of solutions to BIAN service domains and semantic API concepts.
- Provide operational support by responding to service tickets, troubleshooting issues, and performing root-cause analysis.
- Validate and deploy system components into testing and production environments.
- Provide technical guidance, mentorship, and code reviews to Developer I staff.
- Research emerging technologies and recommend improvements and automation opportunities.
- Participate in learning, development, and departmental initiatives.

- Bachelor's Degree in Information Technology, Computer Science, or related field.
- Relevant certifications (DevOps, Cloud) are assets.
- Minimum three (3) years' experience as a Programmer/Developer using procedural and objectoriented languages.
- Experience with DevOps/Cloud platforms (AWS, Azure, CI/CD tools) is an asset.
